Riverton Village Board

The President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverton held their regular board meeting on August 4, 2025, at the Riverton Village Hall, Riverton, IL.

The board meeting was called to order at 7:01 pm. Those answering roll call: Trustees, Johnathan Chisam, Dave Charles, Joshua Zirkelbach, Jim Mileham, Michelle Landess, and Mayor Joe Bartley. Trustee Gina Rusciotelli was not in attendance.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Trustee Mileham made a motion to approve July 21st board meeting minutes and pay the bills. It was seconded by Trustee Landess. Trustees Chisam, Charles, Zirkelbach, Mileham, and Landess voted yes.

Trustee Charles made a motion to approve Ordinance 25-14 An Ordinance Approving Intergovernmental Agreement with Sangamon County for Animal Control Services. Trustee Mileham seconded. Trustees Chisam, Charles, Zirkelbach, Mileham, and Landess voted yes.

Trustee Zirkelbach made a motion to approve Ordinance 25-15 An Ordinance Approving Contract With CASSCOMM. Trustee Mileham seconded. Trustees Chisam, Charles, Zirkelbach, Mileham, and Landess voted yes.

Trustee Charles made a motion to approve Resolution 25-03 Resolution to Adopt And Allocate Funds For An Outdoor Fitness Court As Part of The 2025-2026 National Fitness Campaign. Trustee Landess seconded. Trustees Chisam, Charles, Zirkelbach, Mileham, and Landess voted yes.

Committee Reports:

Trustee Charles, chairperson of the Parks Committee, reported that they are moving forward with development plans for the Field of Dreams and he is compiling information from other villages.

Trustee Chisam, chairperson of the Public Works Committee, made a motion to approve up to \$6,675.44 for repairs to a 2011 truck. Trustee Charles seconded. Trustees Chisam, Charles, Zirkelbach, Mileham, and Landess voted yes. Mayor Bartley requested that he check on the status of crosswalks by the schools being repainted before school begins.

Trustee Landess, chairperson of the Economic Development Committee, also thanked the village employees.

Mayor Bartley reported that at the Regional Mayors meeting he spoke with a representative from DNR regarding the OSLAD grant and that they would be submitting for a second grant.

Trustee Landess made a motion to enter executive session at 7:16 pm. Trustee Charles seconded. Trustees Chisam, Charles, Zirkelbach, Mileham, and Landess voted yes.

Trustee Landess made a motion to re-enter open session at 7:28 pm. Trustee Chisam seconded. Trustees Chisam, Charles, Zirkelbach, Mileham, and Landess voted yes.

Trustee Landess made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:29 pm. Trustee Zirkelbach seconded. Trustees Chisam, Charles, Zirkelbach, Mileham, and Landess voted yes.
